As approved by shareholders at the Company's Extraordinary General Meeting on 26 July, the Company has issued 139,972,705 new fully paid ordinary shares at an issue price of \$0.41 per share to Decent Investment International Private Limited, an associate of Shanghai Decent. These shares, which equate to US\$40 million, are partial consideration for the US\$121.4 million payable to Shanghai Decent and its associates for an additional 43% interest in Ranger Investment Private Limited ('Ranger') and 43% of the aggregate of all shareholder loans made by Shanghai Decent and its associates to Ranger.
